

Admissions Requirements for Application

- Current Licensure as Vocational/Practical Nurse (LVN/LPN) or Licensed Paramedic in Texas
 - Work experience **not** required! Compact from other states are accepted.

- Must complete new ApplyTexas application with San Jacinto College Admissions at <https://www.applytexas.org/>
 - Acceptance requires submission of all **official transcripts** from any institution attended.
 - Applicants are responsible for requesting transfer credit evaluation, contact a Program Advisors.

- Degree Evaluation from SOS Student Account or requested from Program Advisors
 - GPS Report Curriculum Plan: **Nrsg-LVN-RN Transition AAS** or **Nrsg-Paramedic-RN Transtn AAS**

- Complete the online ADN Transition Admission Application at www.sanjac.edu
 - Minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of **2.5** for all combined college coursework
 - Photocopies (pdf document) of all transcripts from other institutions
 - Photocopies (pdf document) of SJC Unofficial Transcript from SOS, if ever attended
 - For contingent acceptance, applicant may apply with up to 2 pre-requisite courses “in progress”
 - All prerequisite courses must include a final grade of "C" or greater for eligibility

BIOL 2302 Human Anatomy & Physiology II (Lecture) and BIOL 2102 Human Anatomy & Physiology II (Lab)
 - BIOL 2420 Microbiology for Health Sciences -or-
BIOL 2320 Microbiology (Lecture) and BIOL 2120 Microbiology for Health Sciences (Lab)

- ATI TEAS Entrance Exam (Version 7)
 - The ATI TEAS (Test of Essential Academic Skills) is designed to specifically assess a students' preparedness entering the health science fields. Subjects: Reading, Math, Science, and English and Language Usage.
- Current CPR certification - BLS and/or ACLS (American Heart Association, see www.Heart.org)
- Completed Titers and Immunizations, see page 6, for more information.
- Proof of honorable discharge from the military (copy of DD-214 required), if applicable.
