# Present Articulation Agreement Between

## San Jacinto College and the University of Houston-Downtown (UHD)

#### I. PURPOSE

A. This amendment is for an emergency grading accommodation to adopt an alternative grading system (S-U) to be executed along with the existing A-D & F grading system. This would provide a seamless transfer of students between the San Jacinto College and University of Houston-Downtown by instituting a temporary grading system in all emergency situations.

### II. Emergency Grading Accommodation, Transfer Credit Under B.

- A. Under extraordinary circumstances (e.g. national and regional emergency; natural disaster) UNIVERSITY will accept temporary grading system that is used by PARTNER INSTITUTION. Reciprocally, PARTNER INSTITUTION will accept the temporary grading system used by the UNIVERSITY for purposes of reverse articulation (e.g. grading on a pass-fail/satisfactory-unsatisfactory basis). The guidelines for the temporary grading system will be clearly articulated and shared by and with PARTNERSHIP INSTITUTION and UNIVERSITY, respectively.
- B. All courses that were previously accepted (using the A-D & F grading system) toward majors and degrees will continue to be accepted toward majors and degrees using the alternative grading system (S-U).
